RE: SAVE Act

Dear Senate Majority Leader Thune:

My Republican colleagues and I write with urgency to call on the United States Senate to pass the SAVE Act. It is only with this legislation that our country can ensure the integrity of our democratic process.

President Trump's address to the nation on July 16th shows the necessity to pass this act. In the President's address, he revealed mass voter fraud throughout our country, and particularly in Michigan — a key battleground state.

Most notable to us were the President's remarks on the substantial voter fraud allegations in Muskegon, Michigan during the 2020 election. Compelling evidence from both the Muskegon Police Department and Michigan State Police documents a coordinated effort by GBI Strategies—an out-of-state firm based in Tennessee—to perpetrate what appears to be systematic voter registration fraud. Multiple law enforcement sources have confirmed that criminal misconduct occurred. The strategic timing of these fraudulent voter registration applications—submitted on October 7, 2020, when the Michigan Secretary of State's office was processing a high volume of legitimate registrations—strongly suggests a calculated attempt to conceal illegal activity. This wasn't merely careless record-keeping or isolated identity theft; the evidence points to a deliberate criminal conspiracy to undermine election integrity.

The implications of this case extend far beyond Michigan's borders. GBI Strategies operated in multiple states during the 2020 election cycle, potentially affecting numerous electoral outcomes. The American people deserve to have their democracy protected from these mass attempts to undermine our election process. The SAVE Act offers the only solution.

Michigan House Republicans have done our part to fight for election integrity in our state. We have passed legislation (House Bill 4765) to require proof of citizenship to vote in state elections, and we have passed a resolution (House Resolution 244) calling on Congress to pass the SAVE Act. But we can only do so much for Michigan, and complete election integrity for our state and country is only possible if state and federal legislators work together to achieve our common goal.

The integrity of our electoral system stands at the heart of our democracy, but this system is collapsing under foreign election interference, serious vulnerabilities in U.S. election infrastructure, and deliberate efforts by intelligence officials to withhold critical information from the President and the American people. With 278,000 noncitizens registered to vote in federal elections, it is imperative that the SAVE Act is passed immediately.

This is not a partisan issue but a matter of fundamental justice and democratic accountability. The American people deserve fair elections that will preserve our constitutional republic, and so we respectfully request your prompt attention to this critical matter.

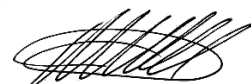

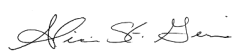

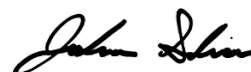
